***Excavation Work to Include Power Shut Off***

*Friday, May 1, 2026*

Please be advised that excavation work will begin at 11:00 AM this Friday, May 1, 2026. During this time, tenants may hear machinery, and we apologize for any disruption this may cause. This work is part of the ongoing spill cleanup along 73rd Street.

At 6:00 PM that evening, power will be temporarily shut off for excavation work needed around underground utilities. We recommend that all computers, copiers, and printers be turned off prior to 6pm. Power is anticipated to be restored by midnight.

A building engineer will be onsite for the duration of the work to monitor progress and address any immediate concerns.
